Aggressive behaviours in children and adolescents have been recognized as critical social, health, and economic issues worldwide. Meanwhile, incidents of face-to-face and online violence among primary, secondary, and tertiary students, inside and outside campus, have been increasing in Hong Kong. Teachers, social workers, counsellors, and other helping professionals have been working hard on early identification, intervention, and prevention of bullying. Nevertheless, the conventional understanding of bullying as bullies versus victims has overlooked the distinct motives, features, and psychosocial correlates of two different types of aggression (reactive and proactive aggression) and victimization (aggressive and pure victimization). Efforts might not be effective as they seemed. Specific intervention approaches are thus essential to address these characteristics of different aggressors and victims.

This webinar will discuss the classification of the aggression and victimization subtypes for correct and early identification. It will also introduce their specific evidence-based intervention approaches and possible prevention strategies in the school settings.
