

# New Version of HKIEd Research Repository

The Library is pleased to announce that a new version of HKIEd Research Repository will be launched for public access on 1 November 2015. Packed with new features and functions, the new HKIEd Research Repository will further enhance the accessibility, visibility and impact of research outputs by the HKIEd community. Adopting "responsive web design", the new version is mobile friendly and can be viewed comfortably on most handheld devices.

Important new features of the Repository include:

# 1. Researcher profiles and bibliometrics

- Provide biographical and contact information extracted from RICH (Research Information Core Hub) and Staff Directory
- Support common researcher identifiers (e.g. Scopus Author ID, ResearcherID) which link to researcher bibliometrics and publication details in major citation databases such as Scopus and Web of Science

# 2. ORCID (Open Researcher and Contributor ID)

• Support ORCID, the unique and persistent personal identifiers which connect the researchers with their research outputs and activities

### 3. Visualized collaboration network

• Showcase visually research activities of HKIEd researchers and their collaborative partners, both locally and globally

# 4. Publication bibliometrics

- Provide citation metrics on publication pages, e.g. number of times a publication has been cited in Web of Science or Scopus
- 5. Page view and download statistics
  - Provide statistical analyses of public access by researchers, communities and collections
- 6. RSS and alert services
  - Support RSS feeds for tracking new updates (including view and download statistics) on particular researchers, communities and collections

# 7. Optimization of visibility

• Enhance discoverability by major search engines, e.g. Google Scholar
